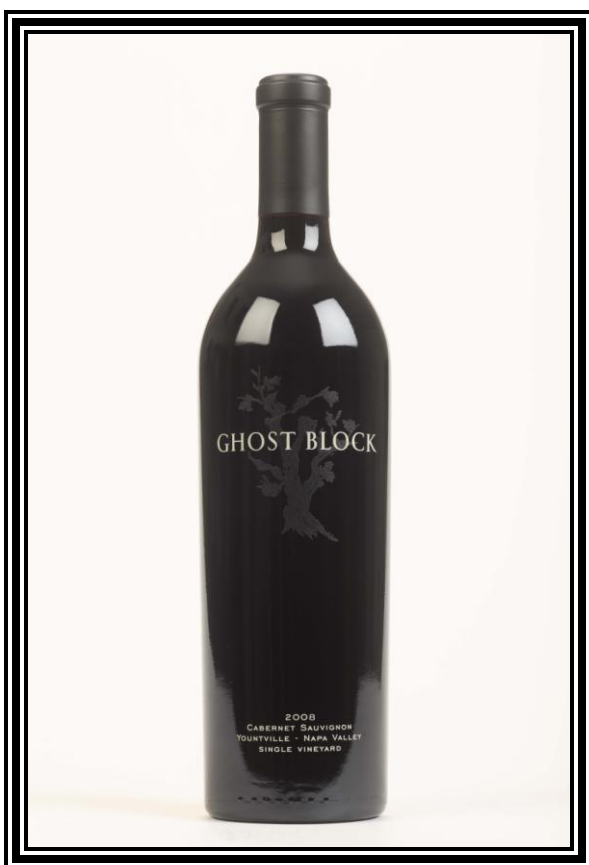


2010 Single Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon Yountville ~ Napa Valley

Winemaker Notes from Rob Lawson:

Nestled on a gently sloping knoll on the north edge of Yountville, Ghost Block vineyard is named in honor of the historic Pioneer Cemetery for which it borders. The vineyard is 16 acres planted to Cabernet Sauvignon. The continued development and focused farming in the vineyard has led to great vine balance and even ripening, resulting in excellent grapes to work with. As the vineyard matures the Ghost Block profile should continue to evolve.

The 2010 is a full-bodied Cabernet Sauvignon on the attack with bright aromas of cherries and mocha. A ripe mid-palate full of cocoa and earthy spice tones that surface with a balanced acidity and heighten the lasting blackberry, spice and tobacco finish.
