

2012 Ghost Block Oakville Estate Cabernet Sauvignon

Vineyards:

The fruit for the 2012 Ghost Block Cabernet Sauvignon comes from the Rock Cairn vineyard. The 30-year-old vineyard in Oakville, Napa Valley that is 100% Certified Organic. The site is comprised of deep, gravelly loam with a western exposure, and the vines produce very concentrated fruit late in the season.

Winemaker Notes from Rob Lawson:

2012 was a wonderful vintage, a winemaker's vintage. The season was very consistent, timely and manageable. The vines reacted beautifully to the weather which allowed for full development and maturity.

Tasting Notes:

Intense, overt aromas of blackberry and raspberry; hints of tobacco and herbs tempting you towards your first sip. The wine is classic Cabernet on the palate with enticing flavors of mature plum, black cherry, and dark chocolate; lengthened by the integrated background of cedar, nutmeg and vanilla. One of the finest expressions of the Rock Cairn Vineyard, ever!
