

2012 Single Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon Yountville ~ Napa Valley

Winemaker Notes from Rob Lawson:

Nestled on a gently sloping knoll on the north edge of Yountville, Ghost Block vineyard is named in honor of the historic Pioneer Cemetery for which it borders. The vineyard is 16 acres planted to Cabernet Sauvignon.

2012 was a wonderful vintage. The vines reacted beautifully to the weather which allowed for full development and maturity.

Explosive aromas of blackberry and raspberry with hints of toffee and caramel. The underlining dry herbs and vanilla on the nose, lead into an enticing palate of mature plum, black cherry, and dark chocolate. Integrated throughout the wine is mouth-watering cranberry, and dense oak. This wine is young on release with aggressive tannins and a dusty finish. Each glass invites you to the next!
