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## VINEYARD NOTES

Flora is a California crossing of Gewürztraminer and Semillon grapes that was created in 1938. It can resemble closely to Pinot Gris in body and flavor profile. We have continued to be the only California grower to still have Flora planted in this state, in our Block House vineyard in Yountville, Napa Valley.

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## TASTING NOTES

Our second vintage release of this wine has a beautiful, light golden hue color in the glass. Aromas of honey and apple cider, similar to a Gewürztraminer nose, rise out of the glass. With weight on the palate, the taste is sweet on the front and mid palate but its bright acidity washes this wine through to a nice clean and lingering finish. More bright fruits and brighter acidity from our previous vintage, make this an everyday wine.
